NEBRASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION NOTICE OF HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

I-80/I-680 Interchange – Q St (WB), Omaha NH-80-9(207); C.N. 22887

Identified as *I-80/I-680 Interchange – Q St (WB), Omaha*, the proposed project would improve approximately 1.79 miles of westbound Interstate 80 (I-80) access road to I-L-Q Streets located in Douglas County. *No impacts to mainline I-80 are anticipated*.

The proposed project would begin about 0.13 miles west of the grade separation under Q Street, at mile marker (MM) 444.46, then extend north to 0.45 miles south of the grade separation over Center Street, at MM 446.10, and east to 0.15 miles west of the grade separation under 108th Street, at MM (446.14). Construction may begin and/or end approximately 500 feet ahead of or beyond the actual project limits to accommodate transitioning the pavement.

The purpose of the proposed project is to preserve the transportation asset, improve the reliability of the transportation system and perpetuate the mobility of the traveling public. The need for the proposed project is based on the current condition of the existing roadway.

Proposed improvements would consist of asphalt crack sealing and pavement marking.

The proposed project would not require the acquisition of additional property rights. Access to adjacent properties would be maintained during construction but may be limited at times due to phasing requirements. No wetland and/or other water resource impacts are anticipated.

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in fall 2024, with anticipated completion in the spring of 2025. The proposed project would be constructed primarily under traffic with lane closures controlled by appropriate traffic control devices and practices. Temporary overnight closures of the full I-80 access road and individual ramps would be required to accommodate some construction activities (see map on reverse).

Impacted traffic would need to utilize alternate routes including the local street system and/or adjacent interchanges during these short-term closures. **Traffic on mainline I-80 would not be affected.**

NDOT has worked to develop this project to minimize inconvenience and hardships. We are dedicated to improving Nebraska's highway system and with your help we can achieve this goal.
