US-385 South of Bridgeport

Identified as *US-385 South of Bridgeport*, the proposed project would improve approximately 0.75 miles of U.S. Highway 385 (US-385) and South Railroad Avenue located in Morrill County.

The proposed project would be on US-385 near the City of Bridgeport in Morrill County. The proposed project would start at mile marker (MM) 71.00, approximately 2000 feet southeast of the intersection of US-385 and South Railroad Avenue (MM 71.35), and extend northwest to mile marker 71.75, approximately 2300 feet northwest of the intersection to accommodate the design of the added turn lanes.

The purpose of this proposed project is to preserve the US-385 transportation asset, improve the reliability of the transportation system, and perpetuate the mobility of the traveling public. The need for this proposed project is to reduce traffic disruptions caused by turning traffic stopped on US-385.

Proposed improvements on this project would consist of the addition of a center left-turn lane and a southbound right-turn lane. Grading would be required for the entire length of the project.

Wetland impacts are anticipated and would be mitigated as necessary.

Construction could begin as early as fall 2024 and could be completed by winter of 2024.

The proposed project would require the acquisition of additional property rights, which could include new right-of-way (ROW), control

of access (CA), permanent easements (PE), and/ or temporary easements (TE). If your property is impacted by this project, you will be contacted by a representative once the design footprint has been established. Access to adjacent properties would be maintained during construction but may be limited at times due to phasing requirements.

The proposed project would be constructed under traffic with lane closures controlled by appropriate traffic control devices and practices.

NDOT has worked to develop this project to minimize inconvenience and hardships. We are dedicated to improving Nebraska's highway system and with your help we can achieve this goal.


